

Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)

What is a LPN?

LPNs are an essential part of the health care delivery system. LPNs perform a wide range of nursing duties including administering medications, transcribing physician orders, assessing and caring for clients, supporting intravenous therapy, and monitoring vital signs. LPNs provide nursing services for a variety of clients in diverse settings including acute care, long term care or continuing care agency, and ambulatory care.

The annual starting salary for an LPN is currently **\$47,814 (\$24.52/hour)**.
