The Municipal Enforcement Officer and the Carbonear Volunteer Fire Department will be on patrol during Bonfire Night.

Fire Regulations

Residents need to apply to the Town Office to obtain a permit for all open fires including a bonfire. The permit holder shall stack all debris to be burned at least 15 metres from uncleared land or neighbouring building(s) and shall not set a fire where wind conditions will cause a nuisance to neighbouring properties by blowing sparks and smoke in their direction. Fire must be attended at all times and a water source must be nearby.

Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony / Santa Claus Parade

The Town of Carbonear's, **Annual Tree Lighting** is scheduled for December 1st at 7:00 p.m. at the Conception Bay Regional Community Centre. Upon the lighting of the tree the Special Events Committee will be serving cake and cookies with hot chocolate.

Tax Collection

The Carbonear Town Council continues to be diligent in the collection of taxes. All taxes were due to be paid on February 25, 2011. If you have an outstanding balance on your account, please contact the Town Office to arrange for payment in order to avoid discontinuation of services or further action on your account.



Animal Control

Pet owners are required to keep their pets tethered at all times. Council continues to receive complaints of roaming cats and dogs. Dog owners are also reminded that licenses are required for all dogs within the Town. Those not complying to the regulations will be subject to fines or having their animal impounded.



Property Clean up

The Municipal Enforcement Officer is inspecting properties and identifying properties which require clean up or buildings that are in a dilapidated condition requiring repairs or demolition. Please be advised that Council is pursuing court action against those who do not comply with clean-up or demolition orders.

Compost Bins

Composting is a natural process that converts organic material - like food and yard waste into nutrient-rich compost. Backyard composting allows us to recycle just like nature does.

There are still compost bins available. Please call the town office to inquire.



Metal Collection



Scrapped metals and white goods such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc. will be collected every Friday up to December 16, 2011. (Weather permitting) If you have metals for collection, please contact the Council Office and provide your name, address, and item(s) to be collected. The regular Friday Collection will discontinue on December 16, 2011 and will resume in the spring of 2012.



Collection of Leaves



Residents are advised that a contractor will be collecting leaves December 9th, 2011. Leaves for collection must be bagged and placed by the side of the road no later than 8:00 a.m. Residents are to ensure they have their leaves placed for collection by the date and times specified since this will be the only scheduled collection for leaves in 2011. Bulk Waste Collection/Multi-Stream Waste Collection



The **Bulk Garbage** will be collected on the following days:

(Area 1—November 4) (Area 2 - November 18), (Area 3—November 25), (Area 4—December 2). Items for collection must be placed at the road side no later than 8:00 a.m. on the day scheduled for collection in your neighbourhood. Please note that the areas are the same as the weekly garbage collection areas.

Residents are encouraged to clean up debris around their properties that has accumulated throughout the year and other bulk items they

may have for removal. Items for pick up can be placed near the street. Glass shall be boxed and "GLASS" written on the box for the safety of collectors. This collection does not include metal items.

Multi-Stream Waste Collection

The Town of Carbonear are continuing with plans to implement the multi-stream waste collection. An information package will be forwarded to homeowners over the winter in preparation for the multi stream waste collection scheduled to commence in May 2012.
